In March 2021, we launched our first carbon negative carpet tile. Our Embodied Beauty™ collection features three styles with a cradle to gate carbon footprint of -0.3 kg CO₂ per m².

Better backings

In 2021, our European business made CQuest™Bio our standard backing or all carpet tiles. This new bio-composite backing features carbon negative materials and helps reduce the carbon footprint of our products by an average of 33%, with no compromise on quality.

Together, we can reuse and recycle old products, turning waste into positive action for the planet.

Recycled and bio-based content

48% of all the materials we use in our carpet tiles, LVT and nora® rubber flooring are from recycled or bio-based sources. Our European manufactured carpet tiles use CQuest™Bio backing, this has increased the recycled and bio-based materials by 1/3rd to an average of 88%.
